Seek trips:

The 8th-grade overnight trips (called Seek trips) were introduced to the students today and students made their *preference* selections. I have attached the slideshow to this email. Also, please note...

- There is bike riding on both the DC and the Cape Cod trips. <u>Students need to be able to ride a bicycle.</u>
- Students who are US citizens need EITHER a passport, passport card, or birth
 certificate to travel to Montreal. Students who are not US citizens need to have a
 passport. All parents of students going on this trip need to get a document notarized.
- Depending on the trip, students who take the D-E bus *may* need to get a ride to school on the day of their trip and/or a ride home on the return of their trip.
