- 5. **The Homework Planner:** Students received their D-E paper planner this week! They will be encouraged to use it in every class that assigns homework as well as for planning ahead to finish projects and long-term assignments.
- 6. **Email:** Students should check email nightly -- I will often send them emails about grade specific things and teachers also communicate important, timely details via email.
